DRAKE RESIGNS CITY POSITION

CAPTAIN J. C. RUTENIC IS NAMED BY NICHOLAS AS THE NEW CITY ATTORNEY—APPOINTMENT IS CONFIRMED

Thos. Drake, who has been city attorney since the beginning of the Nicholas administration, has resigned that office. His resignation, which was read at last night's meeting of the council, was accepted.

Captain J. C. Rutenic was named by Mayor Nicholas as successor to Drake. This appointment was confirmed by the members of the council.

Men Who Succeed to Morgan's Power

While it is not expected on Wall street nor in financial circles anywhere else that any one man will rise to take the place of Morgan, the man who will wield most of the power he has left will be Henry P. Davidson, one of the eleven partners in J. P. Morgan & Co. Davidson has been in practical charge of the firm for three years, and during that time has been

wielding the power of the name of Morgan. That was brought out in the Pujo money trust investigation.

Those who will be associated with him in the exercise of this power will be James Stillman, former president of the National City bank; George F. Baker, former president of the First National bank; Colonel A. Barton Hepburn, former president of the Chase National, and Thomas W. Lamont, one of the newer partners in

the Morgan firm. Davidson is 45 years old, 5 feet 10 inches, muscular, and blond, with steel blue eye and a small mouth, which is little more than a slit. He has great courage, great daring, and some imagination. He is said to be worth \$10,000,000. While the Morgan children will inherit the interest of the founder in the banking house, Davidson, with the advice of the men named, will wield the power.

CITY TO BUY A TEAM AND WAGON

WILL BE USED IN STREET CLEANING WORK AND BY FIRE DEPARTMENT—TEAM HIRE A BIG ITEM

An ordinance empowering the city to purchase a team, harness and wagon for city use was adopted at last night's meeting of the council. The outfit will be used in the work of the street department, and will always be available for the use of the fire department.

ARMOR TRUST IS LATEST ON TAIL

ARIZONA SOLON WONDERS AT HIGHER BIDS OF PENNSYLVANIA CONCERNS, ALSO THEIR CLOSENESS IN PRICES

WASHINGTON, D. C., April 8.—Complete investigation by the government into the alleged existence of an "armor plate trust" will be pushed by Senator Ashurst of Arizona, who today continued inquiries of his own, following introduction of his bill in the upper house just before the late adjournment. He indicated that the problem of government-made armor plate would be a feature of his campaign.

"When the government awarded contracts for 3,000 tons of armor plate March 2, the bids of three Pennsylvania concerns were about \$25 per ton higher than the last contract. They were also strangely close together," declared Ashurst. "I want the public to be let into the secret."

OIL TANK PERMIT WAS NOT GRANTED

MATTER LEFT IN THE HANDS OF STREET COMMITTEE TO MAKE INVESTIGATION, AS WAS G. W. WHITE'S ELEVATOR

An application asking for a permit to build a concrete reservoir, capable of holding 20,000 gallons of oil, in Railway addition was submitted last night by the Klamath Fuel company. In addition the company asked to be allowed to put up a wooden oil tank to hold 7,000 gallons.

The permit was not granted at this meeting. Instead the matter was referred to the street committee to ascertain what danger there would be to adjacent dwellings.

The street committee was also instructed to take care of the application of G. W. White, and act as the members see fit. White asked to be allowed to install a sidewalk elevator in front of the White building on Main street.

William Ketateover, repairs to a dwelling at Seventh and Walnut streets.

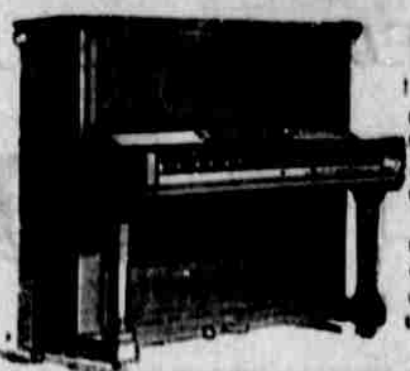
J. W. Jory, addition to residence on lot 19, block 85, of Klamath addition.
