Red Tape Costs the Government \$300,000

PARIS, May 8.—Red tape may cause the city of Paris to lose a \$300,000 bequest from a German who left the sum to be used in building dwellings for working men. Advised of the terms of the will, the Paris city council began an investigation to determine the way in which the money could be accepted. When the investigators reported today they were informed that German heirs of the testator had applied to the courts and had been awarded the entire amount. Suit to recover will be immediately instituted.

NEW YORK, May 7.—Ramona Borden, the 17-year-old daughter of Gail Borden, one of the owners of the Eastern milk trust, ran away from her father, she told reporters in New York, because she wanted a home. On her discovery by her father in Boston and her return to this city she posed for photographs and then told her story in detail, with the hope, the Borden family believed, that the sensation would be explained and ended.

But the mystery remains, and there has been no reason given to the public for the disappearance of the young woman in company of two married woman friends. The young woman vehemently denied accusations made by her father against her friends. She will go on to Los Angeles with her mother, who is separated from the father.

In telling why she ran off she said: "I ran away from the sanitarium at Lompton Lake, N. J., because I wanted a home, and I know I would not have one unless I reached my mother. I was tired of being teased from hotel to hotel, from school to school, with the sanitarium in between. I wanted a home, and I still want a home, and I am going to have a home."

"I am going to live with my mother in Los Angeles, and I am going to school out there, where I can lead an outdoor life and have a home."

WORKMAN in an IHC wagon factory was explaining the various stages of wagon construction to an interested visitor. He picked up two pieces of long leaf yellow pine, and asked the visitor to notice the difference in the weight of the two pieces. The lighter piece, he explained, was kiln-dried. The heavier piece was air-dried.
