**Lowering Goose Lake**  
According to a correspondent of the Bee from Lakeview, many thousands of acres in the bed of Goose Lake will be uncovered by reason of the many reservoirs now under construction for impounding the water of streams now emptying into the lake. Speaking of this, the correspondent says: "The large irrigation reservoirs being constructed southwest of here under the direction of Engineer O. W. Rice, which will in time entirely impound the flow of Drews Creek, the largest stream flowing into Goose Lake, will be completed in time to hold the spring waters. One reservoir is in operation. The construction of reservoirs has resulted this season alone in lowering the surface of Goose Lake eighteen inches, and it is believed the completion of the system will result in the permanent lowering of the lake at least 4 1/2 feet.—Alturas Plaindealer.
