THIRD ST. FOLKS KICK ON CHANGE

SAY THAT ASSESSMENT LIVED BY COUNCIL DOES NOT BRING BENEFITS EXPECTED BY THE ENLARGED DISTRICT

According to the benefit proposition arrived at by the city council in the Third street improvement project, the abutting property is assessed 55 per cent of the cost, and the remainder of the district the remaining 35 per cent.

In addition to talks on the question at previous meetings, a delegation of property owners attended last night's council meeting and protested the matter.

The Third street improvement cost is to be paid for by the property owners in a district several blocks wide, not by those along the street improved, as in other streets.

On other streets the cost is assessed 60 per cent to the abutting property, and on Third street it is 65 per cent against the abutting property.
