OUR WEEKLY SERMON

"Husbands"

1 Pet. 3:7. "Like ye husbands dwell with your wives according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life."

It is worth while to write on this subject since the Bible speaks of them, since one-half of the world is husband (or wants to be) and since the happiness of the other half and the human race is at stake. It is a grand privilege to be a husband.

God speaks of himself as a husbandman, but our privilege ought to be our duties. Every man is born with his character and this can only be modified and not builded, hence husbands are born and not made.

"Husbands have three stories, stomach, intellect and spirit, and a wife may modify them through the stomach." The dignity of wifehood has grown through the centuries until she has become the crown of true manhood, and the test of character.

"An husband could forsake father and mother and cleave to his wife." (Matt. 19:5).

Because this sacrifice was not willing to be made by either the wife or husband many homes have been ruined. This means a mutual clinging to each other for strength, and a growth into a mysterious union like Christ and the church.
