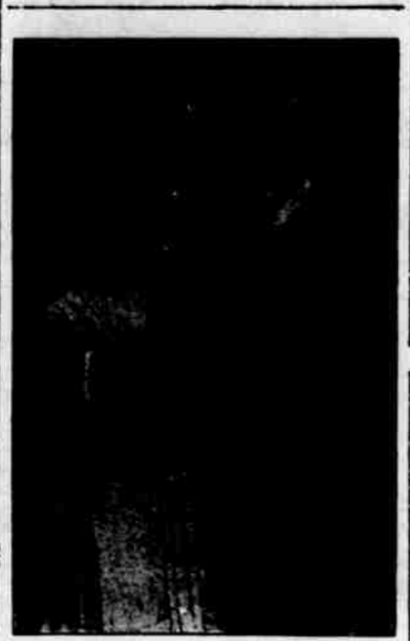

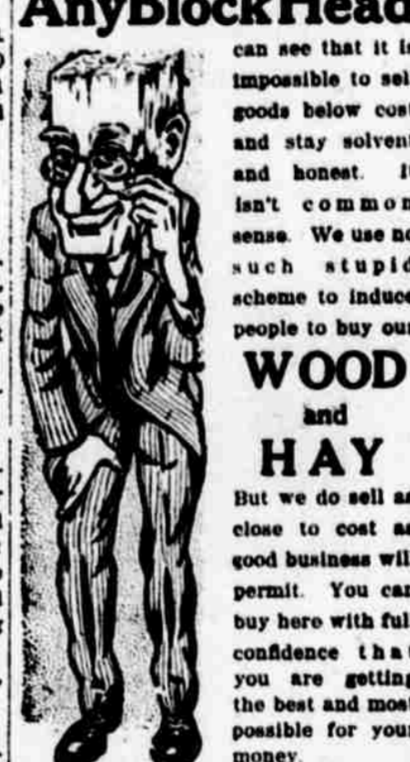
CHINESE REPRESENTATIVES HERE TO SPEND \$1,000,000 IN TOOLS FOR THE ORIENT
