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OREGON GOVERNOR FAVORS OPENING

HAS ENLISTED SUPPORT OF SENATOR LANE TO SECURE OPENING OF THE KLAMATH INDIAN RESERVATION

That both Governor James Withycombe and Senator Harry Lane are behind Klamath Falls in its efforts to secure the opening of the Klamath Indian reservation for development is indicated in a letter received this morning by J. W. Stenema, president of the Klamath Commercial Club. In the letter Governor Withycombe says he will do all in his power to have the reservation opened, and says he has enlisted the aid of Senator Lane in the movement.

Governor Withycombe encloses a copy of a letter received by him from Senator Lane in reply to an appeal from the governor for help in securing the opening. Following is Senator Lane's letter:

"I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st, relative to the opening of the Klamath Indian reservation for development."

"The tentative drafts mentioned in your communication have been referred to the commissioner of Indian affairs for a statement, and until it has been received the committee of the senate will not act upon them."

"I have been informed this morning by the department of Indian affairs that it will prepare a statement within a few days and submit it. After this statement is received I will see what can be done."

Grants Pass Walloped by Klamath Falls; Score 7-3

For the third time this season Klamath Falls defeated Grants Pass yesterday afternoon. The score was 7 to 3. Never at any moment was the game was the result in doubt, Klamath Falls taking the lead in the second inning and increasing it in the third, fourth and seventh.

Cornell started the game for the visitors, but was yanked at the end of the first inning, after seven hits and six runs had been gained off him. D. Osborne, who replaced him, did a little better, allowing two hits and one run in three innings. Higbee twirled the entire game for Klamath Falls, striking out ten batters, walking one, and allowing six scattered bingles. "Babe" batted .500 yesterday.

Grants Pass got her first run in the second on a double by Shandling, a sacrifice by Baker and a single by McAllister. The locals went home one better in their half of the second, garnering two tallies on walks by Nelson and Greenwood, and a two-base clout over the fence by Jolly. The next inning Klamath Falls got two more runs on hits by Carman and Bogart and two errors by the visitors. It was the same in the fourth when Johnson, Bowden and Carman hit after two were out. On two errors and a hit in the seventh Grants Pass got their second run, and in the eighth their last on a hit and an error.

Carmen, the local's new outelder, looks sweet. He handles himself in the field like a veteran, which he is. He batted .500 yesterday. He is a big man, and is expected to materially strengthen both the defensive and offensive power of the team.

Four new players appeared in Grants Pass uniforms yesterday, and three of them, Hornsby, McAllister and Shandling not a hit. D. Osborne, the fourth new man, struck out three times, but did some fair work in the box.

The big game of the year, and the one toward which local fans are looking toward with most enthusiasm, is the one next Sunday with Medford on Medford's grounds. The fans are going en masse to witness the battle and help the team to a victory by rooting. It is expected that at least 150 or 200 fans will make the trip, for they figure that it will be some battle. Medford has a new manager, and it is expected that no such unpleasant affairs as occurred when Medford was here will take place. But it is because such a thing is among the possibilities, and because Medford is calculating on winning that so many local fans will take the trip.
