**DISTRICT ATTORNEY DIRECTS SHERIFF TO DUMP INTO LAKE BOOZE TAKEN FROM ITALIANS AND GREEKS**

More booze is going to be dumped into the lake. District Attorney John Irwin this morning instructed Sheriff C. C. Low to destroy the 220 gallons of whiskey or wine which the latter seized near Algoma more than a week ago.

District Attorney Irwin stated this morning that no action would be taken in this case, but the liquor simply dumped out. Under the law no one is liable for prosecution in this case except Silas Kidder, the old man who hauled the booze, says Irwin. Kidder is considered by the authorities as only a hireling, and not believed to be morally to blame for driving the team that pulled the four barrels of firewater into Oregon.

legal matters, but I do believe that initial advice on nearly all problems could be given by the district attorney without hurting the business of any other attorney, and at the same time help the interested parties in their troubles.

"I think that the district attorney could attend to the preparation and filing of road petitions for the people, unless his position as adviser to the county court conflicts with his doing so. Such matters could be attended to more promptly and with better results if taken care of by the district attorney."
