

HUNDREDS PERISH WHEN SHIPS COLLIDE

Only One Survivor From Tragedy Lives to Tell Story

Vessels Collide in the Darkness of the Night

AMERICANS PREVENT LAUNCHING OF LIFE BOATS

Survivor Says Both Steamers Went to Bottom Quickly—Boodies of Victims Being Washed on Irish Coast Today—Vessels Were Small

The lone survivor of the Retriever, a seaman named Doyle, says the fierce hurricane blowing made launching of life boats impossible. Both steamers sank quickly, he says.

Bodies of the victims of the disaster are being washed ashore on the Down county coast. Both the Connemara and Retriever were small steamers in the Irish coast service.

United Press Service LONDON, Nov. 4.—A check of the passenger lists of the vessels show that between 90 and 100 perished in the collision. So far only one survivor has been found. The passenger and crew lists show that no more than 100 persons were aboard both vessels.

Again in the third quarter Klamath had five yards to go on the fourth down, had the ball on her own 40-yard line and tried to buck the four yards instead of punting. However, Ashland pulled the same honor once and lost the ball on downs.

The gameness of the smaller Klamath team was shown at the very end of the second quarter when Ashland on four downs could not advance the ball six yards for a touchdown. Klamath's hopes were high when the third quarter opened, but after Ashland got the ball in the middle of the field she marched straight to the goal line and over it without losing the ball.

Despite the defeat yesterday, the Klamath fans feel good over this season's football season. Of the six games played one was won, another tied and four lost. Two of the defeats, those at the hands of Ashland, were by scores of 13 to 6 and 7 to 4. The defeat by Medford and Grants came immediately after a hard fought game with Ashland and when the Klamath boys were sadly crippled. Much credit must be given to Coach Chester Higgins for his work in training the local boys. With but few veterans from last year he compiled a team of youngsters into a really formidable aggregation that topped the football standard of Klamath high. Next year he should be a better coach, although he will lose by a narrow margin several of the best players of the squad.

WILSON, HUGHES DELIVER FINAL SPEECHES TODAY

WILSON SPEAKS AT SHADOW LAWN AND HUGHES IN N. Y.

Roosevelt Will Deliver Valedictory as a Politician at Bridgeport Tonight—Both Sides Claim Doubtful State and Both Candidates Have Highest Confidence in the Result of Election.

United Press Service NEW YORK, Nov. 4.—The presidential campaigning ends today with President Wilson's "old home day" speech at Shadow Lawn this afternoon and Hughes' final speech tonight at Madison Square Garden.

The special train of women supporters of Hughes finished its tour last night. Tonight Theodore Roosevelt makes his final speech at Bridgeport, Conn., which it is believed will be his valedictory as an active politician.

Supreme confidence in the result of the election is felt by both candidates. Messages expressing this feeling are being received by each from the campaign managers everywhere. Each party is claiming the "doubtful" states.

TERAUCHI MOST TALKED-OF MAN

EYES OF THE ORIENTAL WORLD UPON MAN WHO JUMPED FROM SOLDIERSHIP TO STATESMANSHIP RECENTLY.

TOKIO, Oct. 15.—(By Mail)—Marshal Count Terauchi, Japan's new premier, is today the most talked-of man in the two greatest oriental empires—China and Japan. His leap from soldierhood to statesmanship with a career behind him that showed only one really brilliant stroke—the annexation of Korea—draws attention of all classes in the two nations and the attention of the occidental world as well to him.

Terauchi is silent, deliberate, masterful—and a warrior. It took him less than a month to police Korea at that country of incipient strife had never before been policed. He is a soldier, and they were good soldiers well armed and equipped in every province. He did his work there as he has always done his work, in the way of a soldier. His name is pronounced "Tera-ouchi." The first part, "Tera," is the Japanese word for "temple." The second part, "ouchi," means "inside." Literally translated his name therefore means "inside the temple," which indicates some of the premier's capacities may have been gained.
