Particles of the meringue remain untouched by the beater; these quickly separate, the small cells burst, and when mixed in with the remainder of the mixture cause the whole to become soft. The whites should be slowly beaten up first, and the speed increased as they SMOKE ASCENDS TEN THOUSAND become firm. If they are made under proper conditions, no sugar need be added until the whites are almost ready for use.
