The woman was freed on the grounds of insanity, the defense proving that she was mentally deranged at the time of the shooting, which occurred on the night of August 3d, at Long Island.

## Red Cross Will Aid Starving Poles

WASHINGTON, D. C., Dec. 3.—The general population, infants and small children in particular, living in that part of Poland back of the German lines, who are threatened with starvation, are the objects of an appropriation of \$200,000, immediately available, which has just been made by the American Red Cross. This money will be paid in two installments of \$100,000 each, to the Warsaw Polish committee, of which Prince Lubomirski, the president of Warsaw City, and Archbishop Kakowski of Warsaw are members. The entire present generation in Poland is facing immediate starvation. The Red Cross has been asked to furnish relief by sending food, as was done in Belgium. The present donation has been made with the idea of extending some immediate relief. This money will be furnished the Warsaw Polish committee just as soon as this committee gives adequate guarantees that the money so appropriated will not result in releasing food or funds for the benefit of Germany. If proper guarantees can be secured milk relief for infants and small children in Poland will continue after January 1, 1918.
