

DELINQUENT TAX LIST

Of Klamath County---For Year 1917

The following list of real property situated in Klamath County, State of Oregon, is hereby advertised for delinquent taxes, assessed for the year 1917.

This advertisement is authorized by an act embodied in Chapter 301 of the General Laws of Oregon as passed by the 1915 session of the Legislative Assembly.

The first half of all taxes legally levied and charged shall be paid on or before the fifth day of April following, and the second half on or before the fifth day of October following.

Interest shall be charged and collected on any tax or half of tax, not so paid, at the rate of one per cent per month or fraction of month until paid.

All taxes remaining unpaid on the fifth day of October next following shall become delinquent and on the fifth day of November next following a penalty of five per cent shall be charged and collected thereon, in addition to the interest provided herein, (Laws 1915, page 184).

Notice is hereby given that any day after the expiration of six months after the taxes charged against real property are delinquent the sheriff shall have the right, and it shall be his duty, upon the demand and payment of taxes, penalty and interest, to make out and issue a certificate or certificates of delinquency against such property. (Laws 1915, page 578).

To whom issued, rate of interest—Certificates of delinquency shall bear interest at the rate of 12 per cent per annum, and therefore shall be sold and issued to any person in the order of priority in applying thereto upon payment of the value in principal and interest thereof. (Laws 1915, page 588).

Proceedure of certificate—Any time after the expiration of three years from the first date of delinquency of any tax included in a certificate of delinquency the holder of such certificate may apply to the Circuit Court of the county in which such property is situated for a decree foreclosing the lien against the property mentioned in such certificate. (Laws 1915, page 580).
