At the Theaters

Two relics of the days of the padres in Southern California appear in the Triangle's latest seven-reel feature, "I Love You," whose scenes are laid in Southern Italy and France. These are a team of oxen, the property of the Triangle's Hartville ranch studio, and an old mission bell which the fathers used to call the Indians to worship. This historic relic was obtained from one of the first missions founded by Father Junipero Serra, the Franciscan monk, who was the first to spread the word of God among the natives of California, and the man who built the chain of missions from San Francisco to San Diego. This historic bell was used to toll the Angelus in "I Love You," with Ama Rubens in the leading role, at the Star tonight.

In one of the scenes in the sixth episode of "The Fighting Trail," which is the attraction at the Orpheus tonight and tomorrow night, William Duncan and George Holt, who plays the part of a villain, fight it out in a swirling mountain torrent, and members of the company who witnessed the struggle actually feared neither man would reach shore. Every ounce of muscle the men possess and every trick of getting the best of the other man was put into play, much of the time beneath the surface. It is one of the scenes which go to make this picture one of the most finished and tensely thrilling ever produced.
