Need of Physicians In Army Is Urgent

The urgent need of enlistments of
physicians in the medical depart-
ments of the army is indicated by a
letter just received from Dr. K. A.
Mackenzie, chairman of the medical
section of the Council of National
Defense, to Vice Chairman Dr. E. D.
Johnson of Klamath county, in which
he asks for an immediate list of
the physicians available in the medi-
cal reserve corps.

Part of the letter follows:
"I am writing you as chairman of
the Auxiliary Medical Defense com-
mittee to ask you to be good enough
to furnish me not later than the 15th
inst. with a list of the professional
men in your district whom you be-
lieve to be available for enlistment
in the Medical Officers' Reserve
corps. An effort is being made at

the present time to speed enlistments
because of the urgent need of our
own forces on the battle fronts in
France and Italy, and in order to
meet the needs of an army that is
expanding rapidly.

"Please suggest only those who are
eligible and fit for service. It is
desirable that a special effort be
made by you in this direction, and
we would advise that a most thor-
ough canvass be made of your entire
district and county, omitting no avail-
able man. One must, of course, con-
sider the needs hereafter of the civil-
ian population, but for this purpose
we must count upon the activities of
older members of the profession."
