CALIFORNIA CANDIDATES CONFIDENT

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 27.—A considerable number of "sure winners" in the race for California gubernatorial nominations arose today with the calming assurance that nothing more could be done about it except to wait for the returns to come in. Such returns were expected from the 1,223,674 voters who registered affiliation to the various parties appearing on the ballots. Of the state's electorate 126,783 declined to state their party preference and so are not entitled to vote today. Their limitation in this respect was shared by about 1,000 other persons registered under various party designations. The "Union Labor" party showed 440 registrations in San Francisco and none elsewhere. One man registered as a "Boisheviki Socialist."

By parties the registration was:

Republicans, 621,772; Democrats, 326,567; Progressives, 18,645; Socialist, 27,899; Prohibition, 28,791. Women, who vote in California, also run for official nominations in larger numbers than formerly, there being two congressional, one state senatorial and ten assembly candidates, besides one candidate for nomination for lieutenant governor. No offices of these caliber now are held by women in this state.

HUNS DIGGING TRENCHES NOW THRU BELGIUM

A recent London dispatch states that according to information forwarded by the Amsterdam correspondent of the Daily Express it would seem that the Germans are anticipating a retreat to the Meuse, as they are fortifying positions along the river in Belgium. The Germans are digging extensive trenches between Dinant and Givet. Givet is about 90 miles directly east of Bapaume.

U. OF O. WILL BE A MILITARY TRAINING CAMP

Qualified high school graduates will have the status of soldiers of the United States army when they register at college this fall, their enrollment automatically inducting them into the Students' Army Training Corps, according to a telegram received yesterday by John K. Kollock, executive secretary of the State Council of Defense, from President P. L. Campbell of the University of Oregon. Equipment, subsistence, quarters and the full pay of enlisted men will be provided by the government.

The committee on education and special training of the war department has just wired the University will be needed for the army within of Oregon that 75,000 new officers the next year, and the colleges will be expected to train a large number of these thru the Students' Army Training Corps.

President Campbell, who is in Washington, D. C., as secretary-treasurer of the American Council of Education, stated in his telegram that detailed information as to the organization of the corps will be announced by the war department within a week, under the selective service act now being amended by congress, to include men from 18 years upward.

Applicants for admission to colleges, after receipt of their acceptance for admission to the institution, for which application should be made to the registrar, should apply thru their local draft boards for induction into the Students' Army Training Corps, without waiting for the calling of their draft numbers, according to the latest information from Washington. Upon the approval of the professor of military science and tactics, and of their draft board, students are then inducted into the Students' Army Training Corps in the college to which they have applied.

Equipment for the use of the Students' Army Training Corps in the fall is arriving daily at the University of Oregon. Two hundred new magazine rifles and 5000 rounds of ammunition were received yesterday, and additional rifles, machine gun, bayonet outfits, etc., are expected to be available by the opening of the fall term October 1st.

Three other Oregon institutions have been named by the war department as entitled to the Students' Army Training Corps: Oregon Agricultural College, Corvallis; Reed College, Portland; and Willamette University, Salem.
