MOUNTAIN SNOWS TO BE MEASURED

SACRAMENTO, Oct. 31.—The water contents of a number of snowfields in the Sierra Nevada mountains will be measured this winter under the supervision of the California State Engineering department.

The object of the work is two-fold; the information will be used to warn people in the valleys of California and Nevada of the possibilities of floods in the spring, when the snow begins to melt.

The information also will be available to guide managers of reservoirs in choosing times to use them to shut off the peaks of freshets, or when to store water to guard against drought.

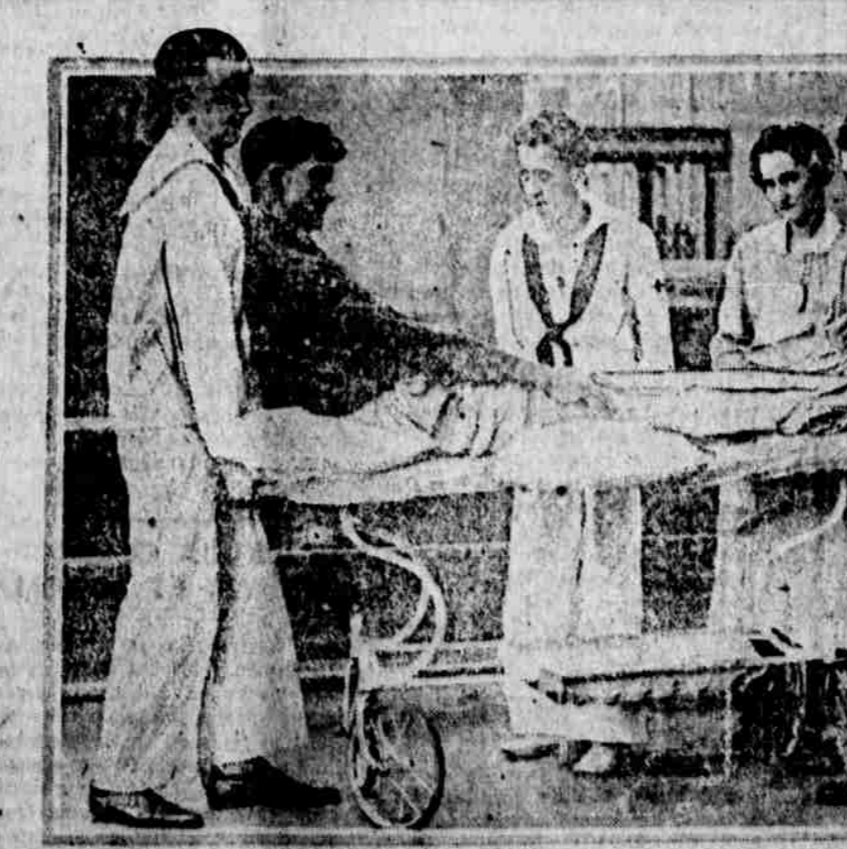
