As has been announced, there will be no drive for funds in the spring, as has been the case in the past, and the funds which are raised will be raised by the membership drive now on. It is expected that 50,000,000 men and women in the United States will enroll as members of the Red Cross during this drive.

PACK OF SLEUTHS GUARD FORMER RULER

LONDON, Dec. 16.—Several score of detectives, the pick of former Emperor William's force of sleuths at Potsdam, are staying at Amerongen, shadowing every movement of Herr Hohenzollern, according to the Amerongen correspondent of the Express, who claims to have talked with some of these men. Herr Hohenzollern is said to be in constant dread of bomb throwers and other assassins, and always carries a small revolver. The former emperor's suite and detectives have added at least 100 to the population of the village of Amerongen, the correspondent states.

OLENE MAN WOULD HANG PRESIDENT

PORTLAND, Dec. 16.—Mrs. Harriet Marshall and Mrs. H. C. Tipton, government witnesses, testified before Federal Judge Welverton that they had heard Harry Lemler, rancher of Olene, Klamath County, say a rope should be put around President Wilson's neck, and he should be hanged for allowing the United States to go to war with Germany. Lemler is being tried on four counts of an indictment charging him with violation of the espionage act.

Jesse Patterson, a 17-year-old boy, testified that he had heard Lemler tell Francis Brotherton to arm himself and get plenty of ammunition and urge other boys of draft age to assist him to evade the draft law.
