CHICAGO, Jan. 23. The late Colonel Roosevelt's love for athletics is clearly set forth by Robert J Mooney, formerly associate publisher of a Chicago newspaper.

"I was in Washington August 18. 1904 working on the editorial staff of the New York Tribane during the presidental campaign," said Mr. Mooney. A boyhood chum of mine who was in government service asked if I knew President Roosevelt and if I could obtain an interview for him.


