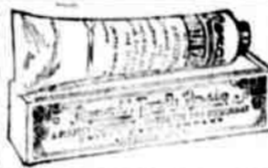

MEDFORD FOLK TRY TO KEEP R. R. RUNNING

MEDFORD, Or., Jan. 29.—An effort is being crystallized by the business men of this city, assisted by the Commercial club and by the people of Butte Falls, the eastern terminus of the Pacific & Eastern Railroad running from Medford, to continue the operation of that line, recently ordered discontinued by the receiver. The Butte Falls Lumber company has recently invested \$140,000 in its new

sawmill at that point and is now putting out 50,000 feet of lumber a day. The Applegate Lumber company, in this city, and two box factories have recently removed their plants to the junction of the P. & E. and the Southern Pacific at the western limits of the city. These enterprises and several others would suffer seriously from a discontinuance of the operation of that line. It is believed that a plan is developing that will enable local capital to operate it.

SALEM, Jan. 29.—The Public Service Commission does not assent to an order of W. F. Turner, receiver of the Pacific & Eastern Railway, operating between Medford and Butte Falls, to cease operations of that road January 30, an so advised him in a letter. The commission states that under

the proposed order the commission would be precluded from exercising its jurisdiction, and that until further showing the order is received by the commission for reference only and subject to such further proceedings as may be deemed necessary. Patrons of the road protested strongly against the proposed closing order.
