

NEW AIR PLANE GOES FASTER THAN CYCLONE

PARIS, Feb. 27.—An airplane with a speed of from 200 to 300 miles an hour, which will bring America within a short day's journey of Europe is the prospect held out by an invention of a French engineer, Auguste Rateau, says the Matin.

Ordinarily, the higher an airplane mounts the less power its engine develops, because of the rarefying of the air. The loss at 15,000 feet is 50 per cent. M. Rateau's device, the paper says, consists of a device providing that the higher a machine mounts the greater will be the speed.

It has been found that a heavy day bombing machine whose speed at 15,000 feet ordinarily did not exceed 50 miles an hour, made 140 miles an hour when fitted with M. Rateau's invention.

CRUEL GERMAN FINDS HOLLAND CHILLY PLACE

THE HAGUE, (Correspondence of the Associated Press) Baron Von der Lancken, formerly German Civil Governor of Belgium, sought refuge in Holland when the Germans retreated from Belgium. Von der Lancken was the man to whom the American Minister, Brand Whitlock, delivered his vain appeal to spare the life of Edith Cavell, the English nurse who was executed by the Germans in October, 1915, for aiding the British, French and Belgian soldiers to escape from Belgium.

When Von der Lancken arrived here he went to the German Legation, but in order to obtain food cards he had to apply to the police station where he failed miserably in his efforts to obtain preferential treatment as a "distinguished visitor." A chance caller there found him in line with a group of unwashed refugees, his well-groomed figure out of keeping with his surroundings. He was compelled to stand in line for two hours before his wants were attended to.
