OMSK, Russia. (Correspondence of the Associated Press) — Serious effort will be made to determine the exact details of the assassination of the Russian imperial family which occurred in a house at Ekaterinburg. Various accounts of the affair are still current at Omsk where at present reside two tutors, one English, the other French, who were attached to the family of Czar Nicholas, and who were with the unhappy monarchs until they were removed from Tobolsk to the house of Ekaterinburg where they were subsequently murdered.

Official personages who visited this house and who had some opportunity of gleanings details accept the story that the former Emperor Nicholas, his wife and their children were thrown into a pit or cellar and there suffocated, wounded and finally killed under a hail of missiles, including bombs. PHILA., April 11 (Correspondence of the Associated Press) — The first name on the alphabetical list of the American Expeditionary Force is Private Anne and the last is Corporal Zzeppenfeld. Between the two names are more than 2,000,000 others.

George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, General Ulysses S. Grant, Robert E. Lee, Woodrow Wilson, several Czars and a few Bismarcks adorn the ranks with intermittent frequency.

Excluding the commander-in-chief of the army and navy, there is but one Woodrow Wilson. He is a private, and according to "Stars and Stripes" has just been placed in the working personnel of Base Hospital No. 25, which was organized in Pittsburgh.

There is an abundance of the names of great men including 71 George Washingtons. The name of the first president is surpassed by 76 Robert E. Lees, who holds the record for bearers of the name of great men. There are but two Abraham

Lincolns and seven Grants; twelve Custers and four Bismarcks.

Among the common people, there are about 51,000 Smiths. True to their traditional predominance of the directories of most cities, they designate the American Expeditionary Force in numbers. There are 39,000 Johnsons, 22,000 Joneses and 11,000 Browns. Sullivans aggregate 10,500, Browns 8,000 and Colleys 4,500.

Whereas, The Common Council deems it expedient to change the grade on certain portions of Washington street;

Be it Resolved, That the grade on Washington street be changed as follows:

At intersection of Washington and First streets, said grade is hereby changed:

West side Washington street, from 279.0 on north side and 279.0 on south side to 270.0 on north side and 268.0 on south side.

East side Washington street, from 265.0 on north side and 265.0 on south side, to 265.0 on north side and 263.5 on south side.

At 170 feet east from east line of First street, on Washington street, from 239.0 on north side and 239.0 on south side, to 238.0 on north side and 238.0 on south side.

At intersection of Washington and Second streets, West side Washington street, from 231.0 on north side and 231.0 on south side, to 231.8 on north side and 230.0 on south side.

At 145 feet east from east line of Second street on Washington street, from 230.0 on north side and 230.0 on south side, to 232.0 on north side and 232.0 on south side.

Sealed proposals to duplicate, each in an envelope marked "Proposal for tribal timber," and directed to the Supervisor in charge, Klamath Indian School, Klamath Agency, Oregon, will be received until 12 o'clock noon, Pacific Coast time, April 30, 1919, for the purchase of the merchantable saw timber on the following described lands: Portions of sections 25 and 26, T. 31 S., R. 7 E. W. M., comprising all tribal timber. The timber is estimated at approximately 3,000,000 feet, all yellow pine. The lowest bid per thousand feet, board measure, log scale, which will be considered for this timber is \$3.25. All timber must be cut, removed and paid for under regulations prescribed by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs before Dec. 31, 1919. With each proposal a certified check amounting to \$500.00 must be submitted. This check should be drawn in favor of the supervisor in charge, Klamath Agency, Oregon. Checks of unsuccessful bidders will be returned, and that of the successful bidder will be mailed toward the payment on the timber as retained as a forfeit if the bid is accepted, and the bidder fails to enter into contract for the purchase of the timber within thirty days from the date of the acceptance of the proposal. The timber must be paid for in advance of cutting by deposit of not less than \$1,000.00 each. The right of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to waive technical defects in the advertisement and proposal and to reject any and all bids is reserved.
