FEDERAL RAIL HEADS GETTING BIG SALARIES

Local railway men are interested in the figures just made public in the Railway Age of the salaries paid to officials of the United States railroad administration. The assistant director general and the heads of most of the divisions receive yearly salaries of \$25,000. Director General Waller D. Hines' salary is not stated. Regional Director R. H. Ashford, of the Northwestern region and all six other regional directors except of the Southern and Trans-casas regions receive \$20,000 a year, and the salaries of the two exempted directors is \$18,000.

District Director L. C. Johnson in charge of the Oregon and Washington district, draws a salary of \$25,000 which is \$5,000 less than his salary was as president of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle system. District Director William Spruill of the California district, is salaried at \$25,000, or \$25,000 less than was his salary as president of the Southern Pacific before the day of federal control. Federal managers, who formerly were general managers, are not enumerated in the classified list unless they come under the name of district manager. \$16,000 salary, for the Northwestern region, but not for the Central Western region.

The head of the division of labor gets \$25,000, seven members of the board draw \$7,500 each and assistants receive from \$6,000 down to \$4,000. Six members of the board of railroad wages and working conditions, chiefly brotherhood men, are paid salaries of \$6,000. Some of the "right howers" of other divisions are paid top salaries of \$17,500 and in the East there are a few who draw double this compensation.

The central administration at Washington has a total of 1411 officers and employes and the regional administration 1085. Total salaries for the year will run to \$6,359,000 and office expenses will reach about \$600,000.

RANGE TROUBLE NEAR ASHLAND

CATTLEMEN CLAIM THAT SACRAMENTO SHEEP FIRM HERD FEEDS VIOLATE GRASSING REGULATIONS, LOCAL STOCKMEN UNIFIED

ASHLAND, May 10.—The sheep people here have just received word that the Sacramento Sheep Co. has been ordered to remove its herd from the range near Ashland, and the California Stockmen's Assn. has been notified to see that the state department of the national and state grazing regulations, particularly in the forest reserves. According to the California stockmen there is a violation of the regulations prohibiting the grazing of sheep on ranges where cattle have priority.

One offender in this respect is said to be the Western Sheep company of Sacramento, whose herders in going from one piece of leased land to another, permit the sheep to run on other people's holdings. The Western Sheep company is planning to put from 35,000 to 45,000 sheep on its leased ranges along the Oregon-California line this summer, and the cattle men fear their rights on adjoining ranges will be ignored if there is not an organized effort to protect themselves.

Grass is grass to a Boscio herder, no matter where he finds it. The two cattle associations will ask the Jackson county Stockmen's association to co-operate in blocking intruders at the state line, believing that a law passed by the last Oregon legislature will assist in the success of the movement. The cattle and sheep men of Jackson and Siskiyou counties have been jointly using the ranges for years without friction and they are ready to unite in an effort to protect their mutual interests.

KLAMATH EGGS TO MCKENZIE HATCHERY

EUGENE, May 10.—The McKenzie hatchery, 25 miles up the McKenzie river from Eugene, will get its share of the 7,000,000 rainbow trout eggs to be taken from the waters of Klamath County, according to Carl Shoemaker, state game warden, who was in Eugene Saturday investigating the Reddish game farm project. Spencer creek, Diamond lake, and Four Mile lake, all in Klamath County, will produce the 7,000,000 eggs to be distributed to the hatcheries of the state, according to Warden Shoemaker, and men are now making the rounds collecting the season's supply. More than 4,000,000 of the eggs have already been collected and taken to the Spencer creek station.

The Klamath county hatchery is only capable of handling a half million of these eggs, Warden Shoemaker says, the rest are to be handled by other hatcheries of the state.

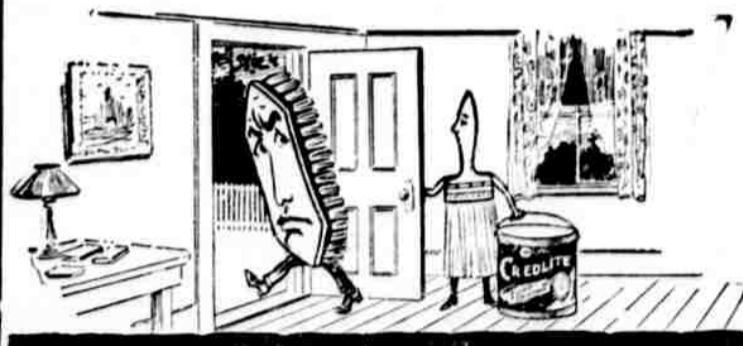
