MOREOVER, THE RAILROAD PROPERTY, WHEN TRANSFERRED OUT OF CITY OWNERSHIP WILL BE TAXABLE.

REMEMBER, THAT ON MAY 21ST YOU ARE VOTING NOT ONLY TO RELIEVE THIS CITY OF A HEAVY BURDEN BUT TO TURN NON-TAXABLE PROPERTY INTO TAX PRODUCING PROPERTY, AND AT THE SAME TIME GET A RAILROAD BUILT TO SPRAGUE RIVER.
