The following question is submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, by its Common Council, pursuant to Ordinance No. 446, adopted April 28, 1919, and duly approved by the Mayor:

"Shall the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, in official capacity, be authorized and directed, for and on behalf of said City, to execute and deliver to Oregon, California and Eastern Railway Company, a corporation, a deed of bargain and sale conveying to said Company all right, title and interest of said City in and to all real and personal property, rights and privileges owned, acquired or used by said City for municipal steam-railroad purposes, delivery of such conveyance by said City to be made to said Company upon the following conditions:

(1) Completion of construction by said Company of standard gauge railroad (equal in quality to the Klamath Falls Municipal Railway) from the northeasterly terminus of the Klamath Falls Municipal Railway to Sprague River, Klamath County, Oregon, and (2) tender by said Company to the City of Klamath Falls of income bonds to the amount of \$300,000, of and duly issued by said Oregon, California and Eastern Railway Company, obligating said Company to pay to the holder of said bonds, annually such pro rata of the net earnings of said Railway Company, and after all interest charges have been paid, as the sum of \$300,000 bears in each year to the sum found by adding the amount of said bonds to the total issued and outstanding capital stock of said Railway Company for the corresponding year, on December 31st."
