DOLLAR WORTH 12 MARKS.

NEW YORK, May 21.-Depreciation of the German mark makes it possible to convert one American dollar into more than three times as pointed out today by the American relief administration, subsequent to a receipt of a message from Director-General Hoover stating that a rate of 12.64 German marks per dollar has been fixed with the German financial emmission for transferring money to individuals in Germany for relief pur-0508

The new rate will hold good during May. Other demand dollar exchange rates which have been fixed and which will apply until further notice. it was announced, were as follows: Poland, 10.5 marks; Finland, 9.10 narks; Czecho-Slovakia, 16.5 marks.
