MEN WANTED NOW TO HELP COUNT MONEY

WASHINGTON, May 26.—The aggregate number of pieces of national bank and federal reserve currency outstanding January 2, last, was 276,825,275 an increase of 300,000,000 pieces over the normal bank circulation under the old national bank system.

United States Treasurer John Burke makes this and other interesting comparisons of the wartime increase in the circulating currency of the nited States in a letter to congress today appealing for funds to pay additional employes in his office. He asks for 40 additional money counters at \$1200 a year; 20 additional expert money counters at \$1,000 a year; 12 additional clerks; 3 additional assistant tellers, and one additional assistant superintendent.

This additional force will be put under the national bank redemption agency and the money appropriated by congress to pay the salaries will be collected from banks in the federal reserve system and refunded to the government.

KAHN FOR ARMY OF 100,000 MEN

WASHINGTON, May 26.—Creation of a standing army of 100,000 men supported by a system of universal military training, is the program favored by Representative Kahn, California, chairman of the house military affairs committee. Kahn, who returned here from a two months' trip in Europe, declared he would propose the plan to congress immediately.

Kahn said that when he appeared before the house to recount his two months' investigation in Europe he will demand early withdrawal of the entire American army from Europe.

"These troops should be brought home from Europe, bag and baggage," Kahn asserted.

Kahn said he found much dissatisfaction among the soldiers because they are kept on duty. He asserted that differences have arisen between our soldiers and the men of France and England and that their relations are "far from friendly."

BAPTISTS OPPOSE A CHURCH UNION

DENVER, May 26.—The northern Baptist Convention here unanimously rejected a proposal for a conference to consider organic union of the Evangelist Churches of America, which proposal emanated from the Presbyterian Church.

The convention voted to join a movement for a campaign to finance religious work of all the American Evangelical denominations, with re-

solutions that the movement should not attempt organized Church Union and that Baptist independence be safeguarded.
