HYGIENE WORK GREAT SUCCESS

SALEM, May 29.—At the request of the Oregon Social Hygiene society Governor Olcott has addressed a letter to the congressional committee before which is being agitated the question of continuing in civilian life the campaign for social hygiene that was worked successfully during the war. A remarkable record was made by the Oregon society during the war and its members expect to continue the work without cessation. The governor's letter to the congressional committee follows:

"One of the greatest achievements of our military mobilization was that accomplished in the combat against social diseases. The emergency attack on these diseases has no parallel in military history and it resulted in the United States maintaining the cleanest army in the world. Oregon

is particularly grateful for this because her men in the service stood in the front rank and are being absorbed back into civil life, clean in mind, body and spirit. The Oregon Social Hygiene society played a very prominent part in this work and has been a pioneer in paving the way for the protection of the young manhood and young womanhood of both Oregon and the country at large.

The remarkable achievements accomplished show the imperative necessity of not allowing this work to lag. The committees were mainly responsible for conditions found in the camps early in the war. The men suffering from these diseases in the main brought them into the camps. But a small percentage of the cases developed in the camps themselves. This fact indicates the vital necessity of continuing this work on as magnificent a scale as possible. To neglect such an important factor is to jeopardize the welfare of not only our young manhood but of our innocent women and children.
