## BURIED GOLD BELIEVED HID NEAR TUGSON

TUGSON, Ore., May 29.—(AP)—It is believed to be the first step in the great mineral treasure hunt in the region of the Tugson mountains. Spanish legends high up in the Tugson mountains, it is said, have been discovered by Frank Pinkley, engineer of the area. The Tugson mountain was built near what was believed to be the ruins of one of the seven cities of Cibola. Scattered over the long, red mountainside the mountains are large numbers of hieroglyphic buildings. Asterisks placed there to mark the hiding place of another great treasure hidden in the neighborhood. They are said to consist of 2000 bars of gold and silver.

The entire region is said to show evidence of rich mineral deposits which declare those who have inspected the mountains that they are the richest to build their cities. On the sides of the mountains, the ruins of many dwellings, white on the top, carved from solid rock, in the Archaic style, stand guard over the silent city.

Nearby, on a large flat rock, are the stone basins that held the blood of the victims sacrificed to appease the wrath of the gods. Hundreds of these basins are said to have been made, each year.

There are five of these basins in places in the vicinity of Tugson and two immediately across the Mexican border in Sonora. Some say that the seven cities referred to by the conquistador, Garcia de Vega, are the ruins of these basins.

A mysterious story of a hidden mine, named House, stands near the mountain, but little is known of the life there.

Ten acres of land on which the Tugson mountain was located have been donated to the United States Government and the plot now is known as the Tugson National Monument. It is under the direction of Frank Pinkley, who also supervises the mysterious Casa Grande ruins near Florence.
