

SPEEDING UP ALLOTMENTS

BY MAKING APPLICATION DIRECT TO THE OFFICIALS AT THE PRESIDIO, QUICK ACTION IS PROMISED

SAN FRANCISCO, June 5.—Have you failed to receive from the War Department your allotment from your soldier boy?

If so, Uncle Sam wants to pay you here may be cases in which no allotment has been received thru error of address or name in the original allotment paper of the soldier or clerical error subsequently in the War Department's great work of keeping records of its three million lighters.

Do not write to Washington, but send a letter to the Demobilization Camp, Presidio of San Francisco, Cal., asking for the form for a letter requesting deferred allotments. Officers of the Demobilization Camp have announced that on such request they will furnish a form which upon being filled out by the allottee must be sent to the Adjutant General of the Army, as addressed on the form.

This will get action quickly, bringing a check by the return mail of Washington. By writing directly to Washington for information it is necessary for the busy War Department officials to write back for additional information, which correspondence will delay delivery of the check. By getting the form from the Demobilization Camp and sending this to Washington, the required check will be your reply.

SOLDIERS TO GET MORE MILEAGE

GOVERNMENT WILL ALLOW FIVE CENTS PER MILE TO THE REAL HOME OF THE DISCHARGED SOLDIER

SAN FRANCISCO, June 5.—Soldiers upon demobilization are entitled to transportation at five cents per mile either to their bonafide home town, or to the point of enlistment, according to new orders now in effect at the Demobilization Camp here, it was announced by Captain Roger H. Waite. Heretofore transportation was granted only to the point of enlistment or induction. Under the new arrangement, regardless of where the soldier entered service, he is entitled to transportation upon discharge to his real home.

Demobilization officers are empowered to transfer men to other camps nearer the home town, or give transportation direct to the home town, whichever is most desirable.

Many soldiers previously discharged from the army and granted three and one half cents mileage, are entitled under the ruling to the additional amount to make up the five cents per mile. To obtain these discharged soldiers should present themselves to the nearest army recruiting office or communicate with the nearest recruiting station. The recruiting station will send a copy of the discharge and an affidavit to the Zone Finance Officer, Lemon Building, Washington, C., who will hereupon send a check for the amount due to the discharged soldier.

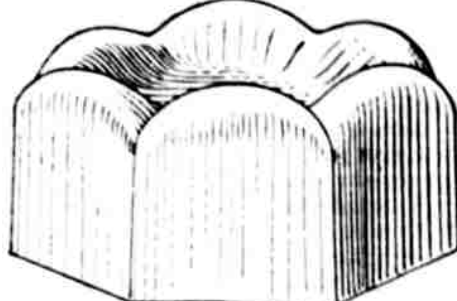

DISSTRESS THRU ARMENIA IS SAID TO BE FEARFUL

LONDON, (Correspondence of the Associated Press)—The sights one sees in Armenia are almost beyond belief, and the tales one hears are too ghastly to be inventions.

This is an extract from a letter an Armenian medical officer, writing from the base of Mount Ararat to a fellow countryman in London. The letter says:

"It may interest you to know of the awful state of distress existing in the country here. Thousands of people are homeless and absolutely destitute. In the town of Erivan alone there are 35,000 refugees. Their country has been ravaged, the houses burned, and the survivors who escaped with their lives have nothing but the rags they are wearing.

"I have been sent down here to inquire into an epidemic of typhus among the native population. It is as serious as it was reported to be.

"For months the people have been cut off from all communication with the outside world with the exception of a small area around Erivan. The whole country has been overrun by its enemies. There are no supplies of any kind and the people are on the verge of starvation, many already having died of hunger."

FRISCO LEADS IN DEMOBILIZATION

SAN FRANCISCO, June 5.—Demobilization Camp, Presidio of San Francisco, has now the greatest radius of distribution of discharged soldiers of any camp in the country, and with the discontinuance of Camp Lewis as a demobilizing depot, expected to occur soon, the Presidio Camp will be the demobilization center for the eleven states west of the Rockies.

There are at present twenty one demobilization camps in the country, eight of which are west of the Mississippi. These eight are Presidio, San Francisco; Camp Lewis, Washington; Fort Russell, Wyoming; Camp Dow, Texas; Camp Funston, Kansas; Camp Dodge, Iowa; Camp Pike, Arkansas; and Camp Travis, Texas.
