

MEAL EATING NOW SAID INJURIOUS

LONDON, June 17.—Meal-eating is injurious to the vitality of the race, Dr. Joseph Oldfield, a London Physician told the Nutrition Society the other day.

"In every country," he went on, "where meat-eating is a national habit the birth rate has decreased in the last fifty years. On the other hand, in countries like Bulgaria, Rumania and Serbia, where meat is not a national dietary, the birth rate is high and increasing."

Experiments showed, he said, that meat-eating produced sterility. Eggs today, he remarked, were not as healthy as they should be because hens were overtaxed with egg-producing food, such as fish, blood and meat. He said that in his hospital care was taken that the eggs used were laid by fowls which fed naturally on grain or in the fields.
