**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED,** That the plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of High Street from 8th Street westerly to 1st Street, including intersections, and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th Streets from High Street southerly to Pine Street, including intersections be, and the same are hereby approved and.
