They have finally closed out the business and paid 113 1/2 cents in the dollar in liquidation dividends, returning in all the principal and about 2 per cent a year interest. 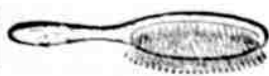

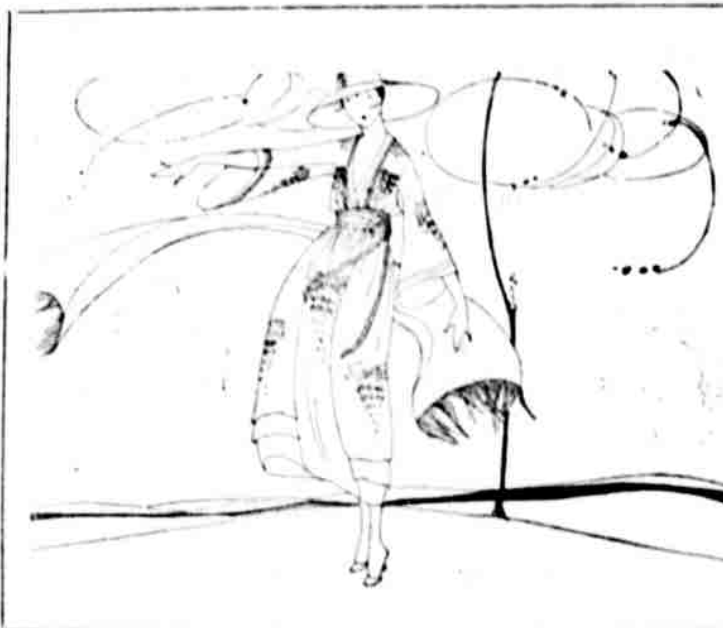
