

BEND LAUNCHES LODGE OF ELKS

BEND, Oregon, July 8.—With a charter membership of 58, representing no less than 33 lodges scattered all over the United States, Bend Elks No. 1371, was formally installed here last Thursday night by Dr. H. L. Toney, deputy district grand exalted ruler of McMinnville, assisted by Francis Galloway of The Dalles, and Frank Wortman of McMinnville.

The new fraternal organization has the novel record among Elks lodges of being the first to be formed with charter requirements as to membership being filled by men already belonging to the order. The territory included was formerly under the jurisdiction of The Dalles lodge, and will aggregate 65,500 square miles in the Deschutes, Crook, Jefferson and part of Lake and Klamath counties. The organization was completed last night under a special dispensation, and it is expected that a charter will be secured by Dr. Toney when he visits the grand lodge next week.

RESOLUTION.

The City Engineer or purport to resolution of the Common Council heretofore adopted, having on the 31 day of May 1919 filed plans, specifications and estimates of the cost of improving High Streets from 8th Street westerly to 1st Street, including intersections, and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th Streets from High Street southerly to Pine Street, including intersections, and the Council having taken the same under advisement and finding the plans, specifications and estimates to be satisfactory.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of High Street from 8th Street westerly to 1st Street, including intersections, and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th Streets from High Street southerly to Pine Street, including intersections, be, and the same are hereby approved and.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Common Council hereby declares its intention to improve said portions of High Street and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th Streets in accordance with said plans, specifications and estimates; said improvement to consist of paving said portions of said streets with oil macadam pavement at an estimated cost, including cement side walks, concrete curbing and grading, of \$53,767.00; or concrete pavement at an estimated cost, including cement side walks, concrete curbing and grading, of \$69,131.00; or bitulithic pavement at an estimated cost, including cement side walks, concrete curbing and grading, of \$66,247.00; said improvement in either event to include grading, rolling, curbing and concrete side walks 4 feet wide on both sides of said streets and.
