PHOENIX, Ariz., July 23.—To conserve and utilize all water falling on the water sheds of Arizona, by avoiding or adjusting controversies and by bringing together all interests and sections of the state in support of one comprehensive plan for the reclamation of the largest practicable area, a general reclamation committee has been formed to cooperate here with the Arizona reforestation board.

Governor Campbell recently announced that there was available for investigation on the state's reclamation needs a total of \$295,000, which should be used, if an agreement can be reached, to assemble the necessary facts for presentation to the federal government.

"Particular projects, for which bills have been introduced in congress will not even get to first base at this session of congress," the governor declared. "The biggest chance is the soldiers' settlement act, and I have been assured that we can get some consideration under this Lane measure."

When the projects that you represent have been well organized for cooperation and the Arizona resources board is functioning, in the fall, we shall be in a position to present congress some of the concrete proposals about our wonderful projects."

### HEAVE GENERAL RECOVERY FROM SEVERE BULLET WOUNDS.

EL PASO, Tex., July 23.—Col. J. Gonzales Escobar, rapidly is recovering from wounds received in the recent battle at Juarez while leading a charge which drove Villa's rebels from the town.

After receiving his wound Colonel Escobar ordered his men to continue the charge down Calle Comercio, and delegated his command to the lieutenant colonel. He then rode to the international bridge, saluted the American commander there and fell from his horse in a faint from loss of blood. He was taken to the Sister's Hospital here where he is being treated.

Among those who have called recently to congratulate him upon his brave defense of the Mexican town were Gen. Francisco Gonzales, commander of the Juarez district, and Brig. Gen. James B. Erwin, commander of the El Paso district.
