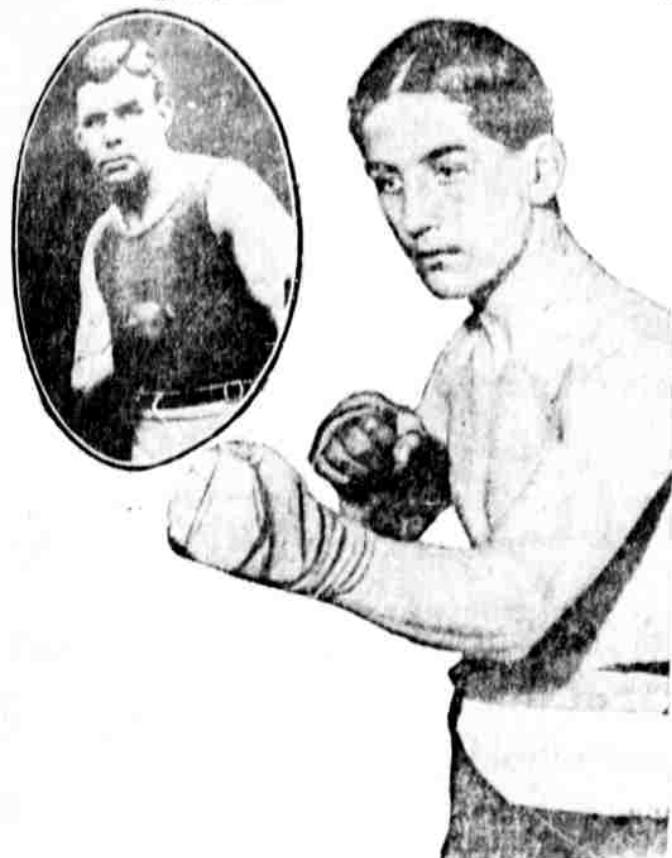

Major General E. P. Macfie, commanding officer of the First division, went to the city and was accompanied by General Andrieu to the ceremony. General Andrieu presented the Cross of the young woman to Mrs. Van Norden and Miss Ely.
