Pursuant to ordinance and order of the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, notice is hereby given that proposals will be received by said common council for making the improvement designed for the improvement of Seventh street from Washington street north-

The proposed improvement will be let in one contract, and the time in which the same is to be completed is fixed by said ordinance for Nov. 1st, 1919.

Bids must be filed with the Police Judge for submission to the Council, at his office in the city hall not later than 8 o'clock p. m. of the 18th day of August 1919, at which time and place proposals will be opened and considered.

NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS.
Pursuant to ordinance and order of the Common Council of the city of Klamath Falls, Oregon, notice is hereby given that proposals will be received by said Common Council for making the improvement designed for the improvement of High Street from 8th Street westerly to 1st Street including intersections, and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th streets from High Street southerly to Pine Street, including intersections.

The proposed improvement will be let in one contract and the time in which the same is to be completed is fixed by said ordinance for November 1st, 1919.

Bids must be filed with the Police Judge for submission to the Council, at his office in the city hall of said city not later than 8 o'clock p. m. of the 25th day of August 1919; at which time and place proposals will be opened and considered.

The award to the successful bidder for making the proposed improvement is hereby made contingent upon the sale of the bonds authorized to provide funds for making said improvement.

The plans, specifications and estimates above referred to embrace provide for the proposed improvement of said streets by grading same to the established grade from front to the established grade on High street line to property line on High street from 6th to 8th Streets, and between High and Pine Streets; and between High and Pine Streets; line from property line to property line on High Street from 6th to 1st on High Street from 6th to 5th Streets, and 1st, 2nd, 4th and 5th Streets, from High to Pine Streets, Streets from High to Pine Street and hard surfacing said pavement on 25 feet wide on High Street from 6th to 8th Streets and 6th and 7th Streets from High to Pine Street, and 20 feet wide on High Street from 6th to 1st Streets, and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 1st Streets, and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, from High Street to Pine Street, including concrete curbs, with either oil macadam, concrete or bitulithic side-pavement, including cement sidewalks 4 feet wide on both sides of said streets. Proposals are requested on all classes of pavement mentioned.
