Pursuant to ordinance and order
of the Common Council of the city of
Klamath Falls, Oregon, notice is
hereby given that proposals will be
received by said Common Council of
the city of Klamath Falls, Oregon,
notice is hereby given that proposals
will be received by said Common
Council for making the improvement
designed for the improvement of
High Street from 8th Street westerly
to 1st Street including intersections,
and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th
streets from High Street southerly to
Pine Street, including intersections.

Said proposed improvement to be
made in accordance with the plans
and specifications of the city engineer
for one of the other of the classes
of improvement mentioned therein
and approved by the said council, and
in accordance with Ordinance No. 471
adopted on the 11th day of August,
1919, and by the mayor approved on
the 14th day of August 1919.

Said plans, specifications and esti-
mates being on file with the Police
Judge and in the office of the City
Engineer.

The proposed improvement will be
let in one contract and the time in
which the same is to be completed is
fixed by said ordinance for Novem-
ber 1st, 1919.

Bids must be filed with the Police
Judge for submission to the Council,
at his office in the city hall of said
city not later than 8 o'clock p. m. of
the 25th day of August 1919; at
which time and place proposals will
be opened and considered. Each pro-
posal must be accompanied by a cer-
tified check on some responsible bank
to the amount of 5 per cent of the
aggregate proposal, to be forfeited by
the successful bidder upon failure to
enter into contract, and bond for the
faithful completion of the improve-
ment in accordance with the contract.
The city of Klamath Falls reserving
the right to reject any and all propo-
sals.

The award to the successful bidder
for making the proposed improve-
ment is hereby made contingent up-
on the sale of the bonds authorized
--vide funds for making said im-
provement.

The plans, specifications and esti-
mates above referred to embrace
provide for the proposed improve-
ment of said streets by grading same
to the established grade from prop-
erty line to property line on High
Street from 6th to 8th Streets, and
6th, and 7th Streets and intersections
and between High and Pine Streets;
and from property line to property line
on High Street from 6th to 1st
Streets, and 1st, 2nd, 4th and 5th
Streets from High to Pine Streets,
and hard surfacing said pavement
and hard surfacing said pavement
25 feet wide on High Street from 6th
to 8th Streets and 6th and 7th Streets
from High to Pine Streets, and 20
feet wide on High Street from 6th to
1st Streets, and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th,
from High Street to Pine Street. In-

oil macadam, concrete or bitulithic
pavement, including cement side-
walks 4 feet wide on both sides of
