FOUR NATIONS AID RED TROOPS

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo., Aug. 25.—Germans, Austrians, Turks and Chinese are assisting the Bolsheviks in the war against the American and allied troops on the northern Russian front...

"Most of the fighting was done in dense woods," said Harcharik, "and we would proceed from village to village with machine gun nests on both sides of our route."

"On one occasion we were on one side of the Vaga river and the Bolsheviks were on the other. We crossed on the ice about 200 strong when a force of some 2,000 of the 'Bolovs' surrounded us. We held them off for 48 hours with a rapidly diminishing supply of ammunition..."

"Afterwards we learned from captured officers that the orders were to take no prisoners but to wipe our force out entirely."

YANKEES BRING HOME GERMAN POLICE DOGS

PARIS, Aug. 25.—America will be overruled with German police dogs if the dog-catchers at the ports in the United States where the returning troops land do not put an embargo on the German product.

All the soldiers and marines from the Rhine districts bring police dogs to Paris. Officers, doughboys and g.I. workers with the army lead them through the Paris streets. The American troop trains passing through Belgium and Luxembourg on their way to French ports all carry a great assortment of the German canines.

Red Cross workers, Young Men's Christian Association workers and members of the Young Women's Christian Association have been won over by the German police dogs and are taking them back to America. Most of the canines have pedigrees showing that their grandfather was a wolf. They are all grey, about the size of a shepherd dog with the pointed nose and sharp erect ears of a wolf.
