## FORTUNES MADE BY SMUGGLERS

Scene of Killing of Austrian Archduke Ferdinand and Wife Crowded Sunday With Merry-Makers. Trains Run Regularly.

EL PASO, Texas, Aug. 27.—Francisco Villa has obtained his ammunition for equipping his men for his bandit raids by smuggling across the United States border or by capture of Carranza troops. It is believed that in the past millions of rounds of ammunition have been smuggled into Mexico for Villa from Texas, New Mexico and Arizona. Small fortunes are said to have been gained by the smugglers.

The United States has stopped the smuggling by wholesale, by compelling ammunition dealers to obtain permits from the Army Intelligence Department and by requiring them to make reports of sales showing who receives the ammunition and the use to which it is to be put.

Nevertheless, it is claimed small quantities of ammunition still are being smuggled over the border.

Villa has often boasted that he obtained a large part of his ammunition and many rifles from Carranza troops. He captured 40,000 rounds of ammunition intended for Carranza at Parral last spring. Prior to Villa's last attack on Juarez a few weeks ago, a Carranza customs official was discovered delivering ammunition to Villa's spies in Juarez.

Villa finances his revolutionary movement by compelling foreign mining and cattle companies to make "forced loans" in return for protection and by seizing and selling cattle, silver and other property. Instances in which he has forced "loans" have been reported within a few months. When Villa was encamped near Juarez he carried a travelling bag filled with American gold and currency obtained from companies in northern Mexico.

It is known that he has captured some of the horses sold by the United States army remount depot at Fort Bliss to the Carranza government.

### AMERICAN JACKTARS KEEP RAIDERS AWAY

RUSSIAN LAPLAND, Aug. 27.—Two tiny American "warcraft," a 30-foot motor boat from the cruiser Galveston and the 24-foot motor boat from the yacht Yankton, each manned by Yankee jactars and carrying machine guns and light artillery, have been playing an important role in keeping the north end of Lake Onega clear of the bolshevik raider boats while the allied land forces moved along the shores toward Petrozavodsk.

These boats, which have been renamed Atlanta and Georgia, were brought nearly 600 miles by rail from Murmansk, and were the first allied warcraft launched on Lake Onega. Since then British and Russian craft have been launched.

The Atlanta had a close shave a few weeks ago in a 50-minute engagement with a large bolshevik steamer which outranged the Atlanta's guns. Some of the shells struck within ten yards of the Atlanta, which sought safety at the beach, maintaining a running fire, but the bolsheviks gave up the chase.

Lake Onega is dotted with bays and inlets wherein a constant game of hide and seek was played during the 24 hours of daylight.

The American craft were under the command of Lieutenant D. C. Woodard of Atlanta. Several American vessels of the North Russian squadron have been at target practice in the North Sea.

### ONLY "FLYLESS TOWN" IN WORLD LOCATED AT SARANAC LAKE

SARANAC LAKE, New York, Aug. 27.—Health authorities of Saranac Lake declare that this probably is the first "flyless town" in the world. Health officer Trembley reports that, despite unusually hot weather in June and July, there are hardly any more flies here than most places have in January and that next year there will be none at all.

It cost the town about \$1,000 to eradicate the fly nuisance which was

accomplished by requiring that manure be screened and frequently removed.

Dr. Trembley regards "swat the fly" campaigns as useless and says the only way to eliminate flies is to put a ban on all their breeding places and he adds, that this can be done.
