50,000 SHEEP SAVED FROM FOREST FIRES

MISSEULA, Mont. Aug. 30—Fifty thousand sheep after several perilous weeks in the country west and south of this city which has been visited by devastating forest fires, finally have been brought to safety, according to word received here. They were grazing in the Lolo forest when the fires endangered them, and for more than a month they were hurried from one point to another to avoid death in the flames, though it never was possible to move them more than five miles in a day.

Fires burned on all sides of them, and frequently it was necessary to go back over the ground which already had been covered, to avoid fires which threatened them. At times the entire flock would balk and refuse to move for hours. Food and water always were scant. But they finally were driven to a shipping point, and not one was lost.
