## MEMORIAL FOR ROOSEVELT IS WELL SUPPORTED

SALT M. Sept. 23.—Governor Ocott has issued the following statement in which he endorses the purpose of the Roosevelt Memorial Association, which is planning to receive contributions from the citizens of Oregon during the week of October 20-27 in conjunction with the nation-wide movement for the erection of a fitting national memorial in honor of Theodore Roosevelt.

"It appears to me that this movement is one worthy of our keenest

support. A high standard of American citizenship has been largely maintained because of the splendid examples which have been continually before the youth of our land in the citizens who have been prominent in national affairs from the earliest beginning of our nation. The name of Theodore Roosevelt, I firmly feel, will last as long as American history lasts. His ruling passion was to be an American and he stood for what was highest in American ideals. Such a life as his is the kind of a life to which I referred when I said that our citizenship had been maintained to a high standard largely through the examples which have been held up to our youth. For that reason I believe your project is worthy of the greatest consideration. The proper kind of a memorial will not only be a fitting tribute to the memory of one of our great Americans, but will assist in passing on to generations to come the benefit of the example which he has held out in both his words and in his deeds. Oregon had a warm place in the heart of Theodore Roosevelt and I am certain that Oregon will help to make your plans that it should be. Very sincerely yours, Ben W. Ocott, Governor."

## MANY FAMOUS STARS STARTED ON WEST COAST

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 23.—When the world series contenders had apparently narrowed down to the Chicago, Americans and the Cincinnati Nationals, sport followers here began to point out the probable performers in the big show who got their start on the Pacific Coast.

Walter H. ('Dutch') Ruether when he was pitching for St. Ignatius College, San Francisco, in 1913, hurled a game against the Chicago White Sox and it is thought probable that as twirler for Cincinnati he will pitch against some of the same players in the world series this year.

Morris Rath, second baseman for the Reds, used to play with the Salt Lake Club of the Pacific Coast League.

The Portland Northwest Club started William ('Big Bill') James, Chicago White Sox pitcher, on his way up. Later he pitched for the Portland Club of the P. C. L.

Other Chicago players who formerly were stars of the Pacific Coast League include: Claude Williams, star left hander; Ben Lynn and Sam Rice (twice); Gumm, once with the Sacramento Club; George (Buck) Weaver and Charles (Swede) Rieberg, formerly with San Francisco; and Fred McMullin, who used to play with Los Angeles.

Even the officials for the world series may be product of the P. C. L. San Franciscans say, noting George Hildebrand once an umpire in the Coast League.

**MEAT DECLARED CURSE OF AMERICAN NATION.**

NEW YORK, Sept. 23.—The eating of meat was the target of attacks in addresses delivered here before the International Conference of Women Physicians. Dr. Graham Lusk, professor of physiology at Columbia University, declared that "meat was the curse of the American nation and the foundation for the high cost of living," while Dr. E. C. MacCallum of Baltimore asserted that unless the consumption of meat is reduced and fresh green vegetables substituted, the nation would be visited with some sort of plague like beri-beri or pellagra.
