



GERMAN TRADE REORGANIZING

BERLIN, Sept. 15.—(Correspondence of the Associated Press).—The much discussed reformation of the foreign office has begun with the creation of a foreign trade bureau that is a decided innovation and a radical alteration of the old-time methods of doing business.

The whole basis of the foreign trade bureau is that Germany must on the one hand have a very exact and accurate news report of everything concerning foreign trade, from official and private reporters. Such information must flow directly into the office of a man trained and fitted to understand precisely the importance of a given piece of news. Men will be trained to study given countries. News from such countries will go directly to the experts of each.

The bureau is headed by an administration board of council of 25 to 30 members, all of them experts in various business lines, and half a dozen imperial officials, likewise experts, will belong to the council. No one, not even the foreign office, will have a veto right over the decisions of the council.

For the benefit of German business, reports from abroad will be published weekly or bi-weekly in the governmental publication, News of Trade, Industry and Agriculture. Individual reports of especial value will be published in pamphlet form and distributed.
