The army grocery supplies which were ordered by the Postmaster in August have at last arrived and are now ready for distribution to the purchasers. About \$1100 worth of the order is in the present shipment. Some articles will be shipped later and some cannot be supplied at all.

Owing to the necessity of using the Postoffice lobby in which to handle the army supplies the lobby will be locked at night until the goods can be delivered. Lobby will be open until 10.30 p. m.
