

WEST POINTERS VISIT ITALIAN BATTLE FIELDS

MOUNT GRAPPA, Italy, Sept. 16. (Correspondence of the Associated Press)—Cadets of the graduating class of the United States military academy at West Point, who are visiting battlefields of the world war, had four days of thrills in their visit to the Italian front, when they were taken to the summits of Mount Sabatino, Mount Grappa and Mount St. Michael, a series of positions in the Italian Alps which were scenes of mountain fighting by the Italian army in the war.

Mount Grappa is approximately 6,000 feet high, is a solid rock projecting into space in gigantic proportions and almost perpendicular on its sides. The ascent is made by a series of winding roads made on the western side in a switch-back formation. There are 39 switchbacks, each approximately 200 yards in length, curving at each end in a breadth-taking curve.

The engineering work staggers the imagination. The bare mountain would have convinced one of the impossibility of the ascent by road, but the army engineers accomplished the task, constructing the roads in such a way that a garrison of two army corps could be kept in full operation during the entire war with supplies of ammunition, food and equipment.

"That surely was a great ride," said one of the West Point cadets to the Associated Press correspondent. "It took my breath away a number of times on the way up and I had my heart in my mouth many

times. I was ready set for a big jump in case that Italian chauffeur started backing up. It was no place to linger on when there was danger."

From the summit of Mount Grappa the field of the operations of the Italians and Austrians could be seen for 50 kilometers. The movements of the armies during the military operations of the war were explained by Italian general staff tacticians who had participated in the engagements.

The chief of the conducting party was Major Stabili, who led a battalion of bersaglieri, Italian soldiers typified by flowing plumes, in an attack on Mount Sabatino, another steep, dangerous rock more than 2,000 feet high. Of a battalion of more than 1,000 men, Major Stabili had but 95 left when his unit took possession of the crag. The scaling of the mountain was made in just 47 minutes after the battalion left their first-line trenches.

Mount Sabatino with Mount Saint Michael was the key to Gorizia and controlled operations for 15 miles in either direction.
