PORTLAND, Nov. 14.—Twenty-five ex-service men today surrounded the automobile of Esammon De Valera in front of the Hotel Portland, while De Valera was in the hotel, and requested the removal of the flag of the Irish Independence party from its position alongside the Stars and Stripes on the radiator. The man in charge of the automobile removed the flag.
