## TEACHERS WILL MEET DEC. 30

The Oregon State Teachers' association will meet in Portland December 29-30-31. This will undoubtedly be the largest and most important teachers' convention ever held in this state. Already the number of teachers who have enrolled and paid their fees far exceeds that of any previous year. Delegates from every county and from every local teachers' organization in the state will attend the business meetings of the representative council. This meeting as well as all of the other sessions is open to all teachers in the state.

President A. C. Hampton, city superintendent of La Grande is preparing a most interesting program and expects to secure for the general sessions two speakers from outside the state. One of these will be H. B. Wilson, city superintendent of Berkeley, California. Mr. Wilson has held important positions in Kansas and Indiana and is the author of a number of well known educational works.

In addition to the meeting of the representative council and the general sessions each of the following departments will have a well prepared program: City Superintendents, Higher Education, Secondary Schools, History, Modern Language, Foreign Language, Council of English Teachers, Elementary Schools, Rural Schools, Vocational Education, Music, Industrial Club Work, Librarians and Physical Training.

## BAN CONFETTI FOR WEDDINGS

MARYPORT, Eng., Nov. 15.—(By Mail).—The vicar of the parish here, the Rev. J. A. Richards, strongly disapproves persons showering confetti on bridal parties when they are entering the church to be married. Writing in his parish magazine, he says:

"All right-thinking people must realize how unseemly it is for a couple to stand before the altar on their wedding day literally dripping with confetti. The practice is also unkind. The wedding day is a great event in a girl's life. Much time and money have been expended on costumes. The bride and bridesmaids take a pride in looking their best, and it is abominable that vulgar, brainless people should be allowed to smother them with confetti.

"Strong measures," the vicar adds, "should be taken to put this down, and we wish to give notice that people covered with confetti will not be allowed to enter St. Mary's church. They will have to come to church in a decent and fitting condition before the ceremony can proceed."

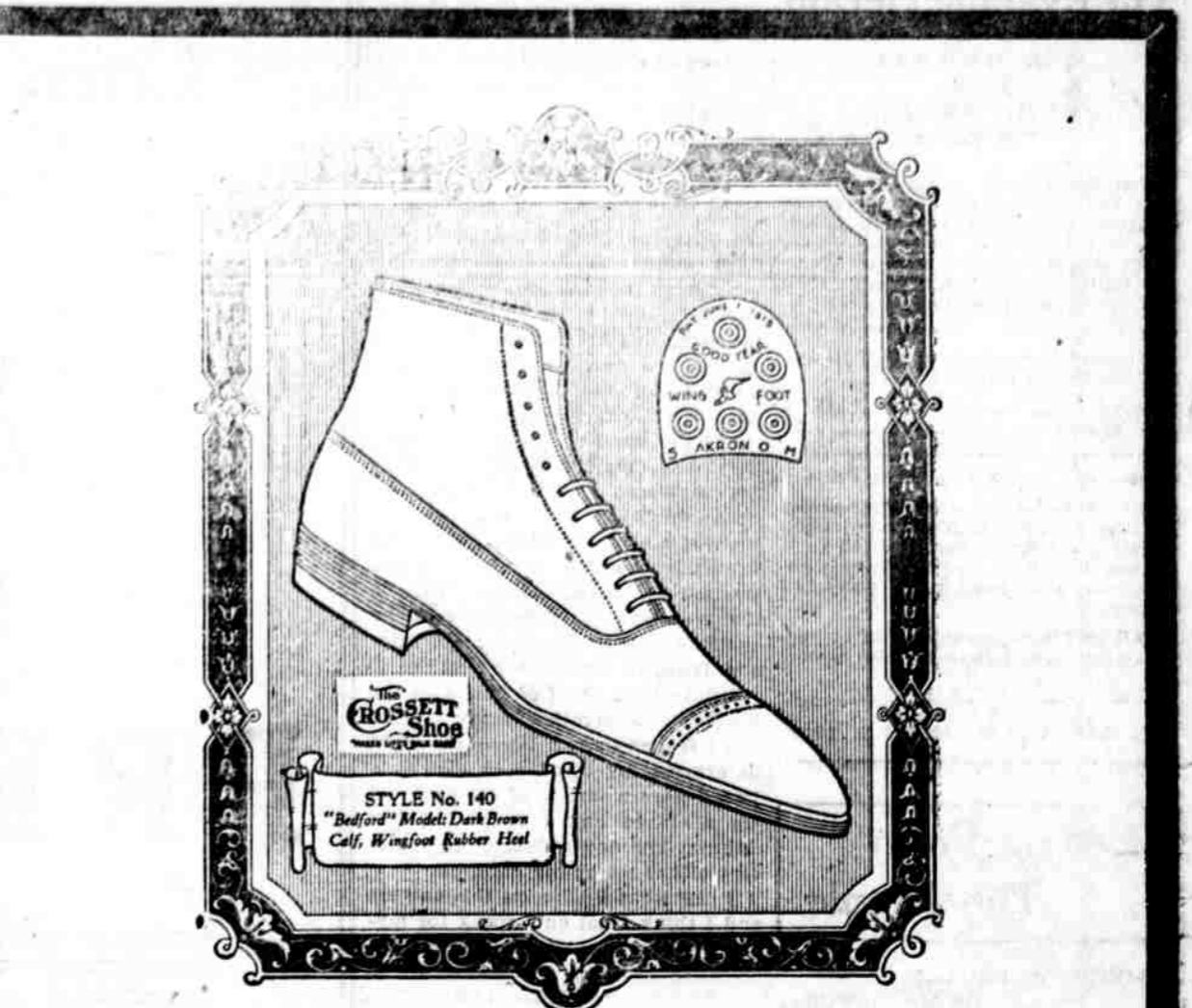
### Can't Lose It.
