

BIRDS' EFFORTS TO DECEIVE

Artistic Deception Practiced by Mother of Brood in Her Attempt to Save Her Young.

It has been pointed out that the military tactics which a commander employ to deceive the enemy are practiced in a limited way by many birds.

There is nothing more interesting in the study of bird life than the efforts to deceive which many species put forth to save their young or their nests from the despoiler.

The bobwhite (commonly called quail) is a most notable tactician in the kind of deception. This bird is physically helpless in the face of danger, possessing no weapons.

There are sometimes a score of eggs, sharply pointed at one end and round at the other, so that space in the nest is economized. The chicks quit their perch before they are fairly out of the shell.

Psychology Expert Decries Some Popular Tests.

Wrong to Judge Character and Intelligence by Means of Handwriting and Photographs, is Assertion of Prominent Kansan.

Judging character and intelligence by means of photographs and handwriting is a senseless custom, in the opinion of Dr. J. C. Peterson, assistant professor of psychology in the Kansas State Agricultural college.

Persons applying for teaching positions or for fellowships in colleges are almost always required to submit applications in their own handwriting and to send photographs with the applications.

"Too often," says Doctor Peterson, "a pleasant smile and clear, regular penmanship outweigh years of experience and testimonials of scholarship."
