DENVER, Colo., Mar. 17.—The faithful service and companionship of his collie dog are remembered in the will of Louis Ferrari, who died recently at Albuquerque, New Mexico, while en route to his mountain home on his ranch in Bear Creek canyon, near Denver.

"Maggie," a wonderfully intelligent and beautiful dog, was Ferrari's constant companion, and in his will, filed here, he set aside a fund of \$500 for her care and burial. When she dies she is to be placed in a casket and laid to rest under the giant pine trees on the sunny slope of Brookdale, the Ferrari home ranch. That was the dying wish of the master, and it will be carried out to the letter by Joseph J. Colla, administrator of the estate.

For many years "Maggie" was a star attraction among the hundreds of tourists who visited the ranch of her master. At the request of Ferrari the animal would go and bring for him any article which he might happen to desire. The dog would keep the wood box in the kitchen filled with wood, which she selected and brought in from the wood lot.

Five months ago Ferrari left for California in hopes of benefiting his failing health. "Maggie" was placed in a kennel, but fretted and pined for her master until she was taken back to the mountain ranch. There she will be cared for during the remainder of her days.
