**'TRAPS' SET FOR TRAVELERS ON ROAD TO FIUME**

TRIESTE, Apr. 3. (By Mail).—The road to Fiume is set with "traps" to catch the wandering adventurer. Nine posts of carabinieri are placed along the way of 48 miles from Trieste and passports and other documents are examined with the closest scrutiny at each.

Seven of the "traps" are on the Italian regular command's side of the route and two on d'Annunzio's side. There are three within five miles of Trieste and the remaining four are scattered at about equal distances apart for the rest of the way until the poet's frontier is reached.

At Abbazia, the wanderer to Fiume must satisfy the carabinieri officers, who are the military police of Italy, that his mission to the poet's stronghold is legitimate, otherwise the visa is refused. The visa given, one must return to the last post on the frontier for the final examination before being admitted to the No Man's Land between the two forces.

Reaching the d'Annunzio lines a careful examination takes place of the mission to Fiume. Scrutinizing of passports ensues and questions are asked about "What are you doing here?" Baggage is examined and false money looked for because of the recent falsifications of banknotes in the city.

By rail, the journey is even more inconvenient. The train takes five hours to do the 48 miles. Carabinieri travel aboard it and make a minute scrutiny of their charges. At Abbazia, all must detain, bag and baggage. The baggage is given a thorough search by the armed custom-house guards.

At Fiume d'Annunzio's soldiers conduct another examination. When d'Annunzio first entered Fiume, no one was allowed to pass into the city. It was necessary to evade carabinieri and guards day and night. Today even, searchlights play upon the various approaches to prevent anyone "running the guard line."

**TEXAS HARD HIT BY FARM LABOR SHORTAGE**

DALLAS, Tex., Apr. 29.—Farm labor shortage, which is threatening to become acute in Texas, has not caused farmers to reduce acreage planted to any appreciable extent, according to S. D. Frazer, secretary of the Texas Cotton Ginners' association. The wheat acreage will be reduced as compared with last year, but the cotton and corn planting probably will be normal, he said, and an increase is likely in oats and small grain.

**CALIFORNIANS CAN'T TRAVEL ON \$6 A DAY**

SACRAMENTO, Cal., Apr. 29.—Members of the state board of education have appealed to the board of control for an increase of the \$6 a

day allowance made for maintenance and quarters of state officials when away from home on official duty. Rules now in force allow three meals at \$2 each and room that shall not exceed \$3. Fifty cents additional is granted for each meal when purchased on a dining car.
