TRADE CONVENTION AT S. F. MAY 12-15

SAN FRANCISCO, May 3.—Three special trains are scheduled to cross the continent with delegates to the national foreign trade convention to be held here May 12-15. In addition commercial organizations of the Pacific northwest are planning to charter passenger steamships to carry delegates south from Seattle, Tacoma and Portland.

All three special trains will start from New York. The first is due to leave May 4 over the northern route.

picking up delegates at Boston, Buffalo, Chicago, St. Paul, Seattle, Tacoma and Portland. The other two trains leave May 5. One will take the central route via Philadelphia, Cincinnati, St. Louis, Kansas City and Ogden and the other will follow the southern lines, touching Washington, Atlanta, New Orleans, El Paso and Los Angeles. EIGHT CITIES DOUBLE SIZE IN TEN YEARS

WASHINGTON, May 4.—Eight cities of 25,000 or more population, out of more than 60 whose census for 1920 thus far has been announced, have more than doubled their population within the last 10 years. Two have shown a decrease. Kenmore, O., a city of 12,683, has shown an increase of 712.5 per cent; Dormont, Pa., a city of 6,455, increased 478.9 per cent, while of the cities having 25,000 or more population Gary, Ind., has shown 229.4 per cent.

Akron, O., is the largest city which has more than doubled in population, its rapid growth of 201.8 per cent to a population of 208,435, changing its rank from 81st city of the country in 1910 to a position probably between 30th and 40th rank. It has passed Syracuse, N. Y.; Memphis, Tenn.; Dayton, O.; Nashville, Tenn.; Albany, N. Y., and Kansas City, Kan., cities having more than 100,000, as well as a number of smaller cities ranking above it in 1910.

The two cities of 25,000 population which have shown decreases are Newport, Ky., with a decline of 3.3

per cent, to 29,317, and Kingston, N. Y., with a decline of 0.1 per cent to 25,884. Thirty other places have shown decreases ranging up to 24.2 per cent shown by Stillwater, Minn.

COMBINED COTTON MARKETING PLAN

PHOENIX, Ariz., May 3.—Co-operative marketing of the entire cotton crop of the United States is contemplated in a plan being devised by the American Cotton association, according to W. S. Stevens, president of the Arizona branch, the Arizona-American-Egyptian Cotton Growers' association, on his return from the annual convention of the national association at Montgomery, Ala.

As a start toward national co-operative marketing of cotton, the various branches of the association have tried co-operative marketing this year on a small scale, according to Mr. Stevens, and the experiment has proved so successful as to warrant working out a national plan to eliminate middle men and give a larger profit to the cotton grower.

To formulate this plan, a national commission, appointed by the association, will study the marketing methods of all successful marketing associations, both domestic and foreign, Mr. Stevens said.
